### IOI 2012 Tours MILAN

Milan, the capital of Lombardy, has a population of 1.3 million people. It is the biggest industrial city in Italy with many different manufacturing sectors and the centre of Italian fashion. It is a magnet for designers, artists, photographers and models. Milan also has an ancient city centre with many fascinating buildings, another reason why so many people from all over the world flock to see this hard-working but vibrant and glamorous city.

Milan Municipality and Assolombarda (the Lombard entrepreneurs association) have organized a day in Milan as outlined below:

#### **Morning**

In conjunction with IOI 2012, the Lombardy Regional Education Authority and AICA, together with Assolombarda and UNESCO, have organized an International conference on Young Talent and the Digital Future. The list of speakers includes Ms. Irina Bukova (DG Unesco), Mr. Francesco Profumo (Italian Minister of Education), Assolombarda President, AICA CEO, former IOI Champions, and other personalities. Findings of the survey on Young Talent in Informatics conducted by AICA and IT STAR will be

presented during the conference and a copy of the study distributed to attendees.

#### Afternoon

After a buffet lunch in Assolombarda, a walking tour through the historic centre of Milan is scheduled and will include: Palazzo Reale, the Duomo (Milan Cathedral), the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II (an elegant covered arcade where the Milanese love to promenade), Piazza della Scala (world famous La Scala Opera House), Palazzo Marino (Milan City Hall), Piazza Mercanti (a medieval market square), Via Dante and the Sforza Castle (with a visit to the Rondanini Pietà, Michelangelo's last work, and Leonardo da Vinci's drawings).

## IOI 2012 Tours VENICE

Venice welcomes the competitors of IOI 2012, soon to discover the charm of its artistic and architectural heritage.

The visit starts with a cruise along Venice's main waterway, the Grand Canal, which cuts through the heart of the city for almost 4 km.

Many beautiful palaces and churches line the banks of the Canal: the magnificent 17th century Palazzo Labia; the Fondaco dei Turchi founded in the 13th century; the famous Ca' d'Oro, probably the most beautiful example of Venetian floral gothic architecture, and many others.

Just before the Rialto Bridge, there is the lively Pescaria, the fish market, and the Fondaco dei Tedeschi, now the main Post Office. After the bridge are the Ca' Loredan and the Ca' Farsetti, both from the 13th century.

The Canal ends in St Mark's Basin where there will be a pause to take in the Doge's Palace and St Mark's Basilica, Venice's most renowned landmark.

The Doge's Palace ruled the Republic of Venice until 1797. Rebuilt several times, it is decorated with artistic masterpieces, amongst which can be seen paintings by



Tintoretto, Titian and Veronese. At the heart of the Palace is the great Sala del Maggior Consiglio where, from 1200 on, Venetian nobles gathered to legislate.

St Mark's Basilica, with its characteristic cupolas and precious gold mosaics, was built in 828 to house the remains of St Mark, stolen from Alexandria by two Venetian merchants.

The trip ends with a visit to the Arsenal, the source of Venetian sea power since the 12th century. The powerful ships built here enabled the creation of the Venetian commercial empire and its defence against Turkish expansion. The arsenal was organised like an assembly line and covered a vast area.

### 101 2012 Tours GARDALAND / BRESCIA

#### **Gardaland amusement park**

Gardaland is the most renowned amusement park in Italy, the one with the longest history and one of the highest reputations in Europe. In 2005, the magazine Forbes ranked Gardaland as fifth among the amusement parks in the world! Lying on the south-eastern shores of Lake Garda, the amusement Park offers themed areas ranging from history to geography, space and fantasy. The huge variety of attractions aim at satisfying a truly diversified crowd: from early childhood to third age, from teen groups to families.

#### **Brescia**

Overlooked by an imposing castle, Brescia seems to hide its treasures jealously. It is enough to have a walk in piazza del Foro where the ruins of the Roman temple, theatre and basilica lie, or to stroll round the wonderful domus (villas) in the nearby museum to experience the Roman age again. This archaeological area and the monastic complex of San Salvatore-Santa Giulia are registered in the UNESCO World Heritage List. The Duomo Vecchio (old cathedral) and the Broletto are outstanding examples of Medieval architecture. The Loggia and

the church of Santa Maria dei Miracoli are gems of the Renaissance. Tiziano left his mark in the church of Santi Nazaro e Celso. The Duomo Nuovo (new cathedral) has an imposing white Botticino marble façade. Not to mention many other churches, squares, fountains and palaces which hide airy courtyards and spectacular gardens. Brescia is also at the peak of the national economic survey and it is the heir of an ancient tradition of handcraft, industry and trade.

The town is the proud homeland of the historic Mille Miglia (Thousand mile) car race. Every year, in May, numerous veteran car enthusiasts come from all over the world to take part in the competition.

### 101 2012 Tours LAKE GARDA

#### Gardone Riviera and Salò

Gardone Riviera, a village on the shores of Lake Garda, used to be an important centre for the cultivation of olives, lemons and limes. In 1921 Gardone became the residence of the soldier and poet Gabriele D'Annunzio (1863-1938). On a slope overlooking the lake he realized, with the help of the architect Maroni, a complex of buildings, streets, squares, gardens, waterways and an outdoor theater. He named the area "Italian Vittoriale", in memory of his "incomparable life 'and of the feats he accomplished during the First World War, Salò, founded by the Romans. became the capital of a vast territory during the period of Venetian rule (1423-1796). Its mayor ruled the town and the countryside with a mandate to administer justice too. From 1943 to 1945 it was the seat of the government of the Italian Social Republic.

#### **Sirmione**

Sirmione is an ancient fishing village nestled on a peninsula sticking out into the water of Lake Garda for about 4 km, in a beautiful natural setting. Known since ancient times for its healthy water, it is a resort of international fame and it has earned several times the



"Blue Flag", awarded to locations that stand out for water quality, clean beaches and level of tourist services. The town is rich in artistic and historical treasures embedded in the romantic atmosphere of narrow streets and small squares. The Rocca Scaligera (XIII c.) dominates the town entrance. Completely surrounded by water, the castle is a miniature architectural jewel of towers, courtyards and drawbridge. The churches Sant'Anna della Rocca (XIV c.), Santa Maria Maggiore (XV c.), San Pietro in Mavino (VIII c.) are of great artistic importance. A pleasant walk through olive groves leads to the Grotte di Catullo, the remains of the largest uncovered Roman villa in northern Italy.


